* For the circuit scorecards only, we treated certain consolidated cases as separate decisions rather than as one. For consolidated cases that stemmed from different lower court decisions, such as *Riley v. California* (Cal.) and *United States v. Wurie* (1st Cir.), we looked at the two cases separately to most accurately reflect the Supreme Court's treatment of the precedents below: a reversal of the California Supreme Court in *Riley* and an affirmance of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the First Circuit in *Wurie*. For cases that were consolidated in the court below, such as the three cases from the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit consolidated in *Chadbourne & Parke LLP v. Troice*, we counted the Supreme Court's decision only once. Throughout the rest of the Stat Pack consolidated cases are uniformly treated as a single case.

This chart features affirmance and reversal rates for each circuit and each Justice. The first number is the number of times a particular Justice voted to affirm a decision of the court below and the second number is the number of times that Justice voted to vacate or reverse the decision below.
